#### GUIDELINES & ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

#### Rules & Regulations:

#### Rule 1-

- Those who are interested in participating must register themselves.
- The registration fee is Rs. 500+GST for each team.
- The team must consist a minimum of 4 members. The maximum number of members is 10.
- The last date for registration is 15th January, 2024.
- The team shall designate one of its members as the "Contact Person" in the registration form and fill the required contact details of the same in the form.
- All updates and notifications regarding the competition will be mailed to the "Contact Person".
- Any alteration in the number of team members or substitution of members must be informed to us through the specified email address.

#### Rule 2-

- The registered participants must submit an original script of a skit on the given theme.
- The scripts must be original and plagiarism must be avoided.
- The scripts have to be submitted on the google form and the link for the same will be mailed once registration is successful.

#### Rule 3- (Submission Guidelines)

- The script shall be typed on A4 size page in Font type- Times New Roman,
- Font size: 12, 1.5-linespacing & 1-inch margin on each side.
- All the pages of the script should have page numbers at the bottom.

#### **Teams Participation**

• There is no bar on the number of entries per institution.

#### **Eligibility**

- All students perusing any course from any any college or university
- All school students are eligible from class 9th 12th.

#### **Last Date of Registration**

- Last date of registration is January 15, 2024
- Last date of script submission for 1st round is January 17, 2024.

#### **Registration fee:**

• Registration fee of Rs. 500 per team.

#### Marking Scheme (Final Round)

- Each team will get 12 minutes to perform on stage.
- After 12 minutes negative marking will begin as 1 marks will be deducted for exceeding 1 extra minute, similarly 2 marks will be deducted for exceeding 1 more extra minute and so on.



# MAIN THEME:-"SIDE EFFECT OF WOMEN EMPOWERMENT ON THE SOCIETY IN PRESENT SCENARIO"

- Only soft copies of scripts shall be submitted in both pdf and doc format.

# HIT THE BUZZ

## GUIDELINES & ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

- Hit The Buzz is the general quiz of Lex Carnival which will test the knowledge of the participating teams in general knowledge. The quiz shall have topics ranging from entertainment, sports, world affairs to current affairs.
- Each team shall contain a maximum of 3 participants.
- Students from class 9th and above and college students are eligible to participate in the quiz.
- There will be 2 rounds in the quiz, preliminary and finals.

#### **Format**

#### 1. Prelims: 31st January 2024

Venue: Classroom

Mode: Offline (On Paper)

#### MCQ Round:

{15+ (5 Tie Breaker) = 20 Questions: 15 Minutes}

- The participants will be given 15 minutes to answer 20 questions.
- Each question will have 4 options to it.
- Top 8 teams will qualify for the final round of Hit The Buzz.
- In case of a tie, the finalists will be selected on the basis of the number of tie breaker questions they attempt correctly.

#### **Composition of teams:**

• Participants can participate individually or in a team of 2 or 3 Members.

#### **Eligibility:**

• Students from class 9th and above and college students are eligible to participate in the quiz.

#### **Last Date of Registration:**

- Last date of registration is January 26, 2024.
- Date for the final round is January 31, 2024.

#### **Registration fees:**

• Registration fee of Rs. 500 per Team/Individually.



## 2. Final Round: (8 Teams) 31st January 2024

Venue: Auditorium Mode: On Stage

The qualifying teams will be invited on the stage for the finals of Hit The Buzz.

#### 1.Buzz

8 Questions

Direct Question: +10 : No Negative

Buzzed: +05 : No Negative

• There will be 8 questions in total, 1 for each team.

- 30 Second time will be provided to each team.
- The participants will press the buzzer to Buzz the question
- For a correct Direct answer, 10 points will be awarded.
- For a correct Buzz answer, 5 points will be awarded.
- No negative points for wrong answer.

#### 2. Numero Grid

4x3 Grid = 12 Questions Correct Answer: +20 Point Wrong Answer: No Negative

- There shall be a 4x3 grid with each tile numbered up to 12.
- Each tile shall contain a question which will only be revealed after a team selects it.
- The questions will also include audio visual questions.
- 45 seconds will be provided to each team.
- 20 points will be awarded to the team for a correct answer.
- No negative points for the wrong answers.
- 1 Question for each team.

#### 3. Run It Random

8 Questions

Correct Answer: +30 Wrong Answer: -10

- There will be 8 questions in total.
- 20 seconds will be provided to answer, after the riddle has been read.
- The team shall press the buzzer to register their answer to the quizmaster.
- 30 points will be awarded for the correct answer.
- 10 points will be deducted for the wrong answer.
- Two lowest scoring teams on the scoreboard, will be eliminated from the stage rounds and 6 Teams will move forward to the next round.

#### 4. Pick your poison [6 Teams]

12 Categories = 12 Questions

Correct Answer: +40 Wrong Answer: -20

- There will be 12 topics from which the teams will choose one topic of their choice.
- The question will be related to the topic only.
- 40 points will be awarded for the correct answer.
- 20 points will be deducted for a wrong answer.
- 1 Minute time will be provided to each team
- Each team can ask for two hints but the points to be awarded will reduce with consecutive hints:
- First Hint: +25
- Second Hint: +10
- Two lowest scoring teams on the scoreboard, will be eliminated from the stage rounds and 4 Teams will move forward to the final round.

25 Questions

Correct Answer: +50 Wrong Answer: -30

- The final round of the event.
- 25 questions will be asked in total.
- Whichever team presses the buzzer first shall answer the question.

## GUIDELINES & ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

- Lex Carnival'24 is hosting its first edition of Half A Minute. This event shall test participants on their spontaneity of thoughts, candour of words and agility of interjection.
- We are of the belief that for a good debator and a good lawyer, the spontaneity of their arguments and the candid nature of it, is of extreme importance.
- Half A Minute aims at testing these skills of the participants when the stove is turned on and everyone is feeling the heat of the event.

#### **Rules And Regulations**

- Two participants shall be called on the stage.
- Each participant will be given a topic, onthe-spot, with 10 seconds of preparation time and the speaking time shall be of 30 Seconds.
- Topic will be picked by the participants from a bowl of chits.
- The participant must speak on the subject for 30 seconds without repeating their content, deviating from the subject or pausing for too long.
- The event will be conducted in a Tournament Bracket Format.
- The bracket table will be made available within 2 days of the date from which the registrations close.

#### **Composition of teams:**

• Each team shall have only 1 participant.

#### **Eligibility:**

• Students from class 9th – 12th and college students are allowed to participate in the quiz.

#### **Last Date of Registration:**

- Last date of registration is 26th January 2024.
- Date for the finals is 1st February 2024.

#### **Registration fees:**

• Registration fee of Rs. 500 per Team.



- When a participant raises an interjection and it is awarded as valid, then they shall continue speaking for the rest of the remaining seconds of the time.
- Participants can only use English. Use of any other language shall lead to negative marking of -5.





## **Evaluation Criteria**

- The participants will be judged on the following criteria:
  - Total time spoken (The total number of seconds the speaker has spoken for): +1 for every valid second that the speaker speaks for.
  - Valid Interjections: +5 for every valid interjection made by the participants.
  - o Invalid Interjections: -3 for every invalid interjection made by the participants.
  - Facts spoken: On a scale of 1 to 5, for the facts presented
- The following interjections would be counted as Valid Interjections:
  - o Repetition: If a participant repeats a fact or a line in his speech.
  - o Deviation from the topic: If a participant deviates from the topic.
  - Long Pause/Thinking Pause: If a participant takes a long pause for thinking during the speaking time. (Breathing pause is allowed and it will be the judge's discretion to decide if the pause was a thinking pause or a breathing pause.)
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

#### Round Two

- Questions will be based on MCQ format. Participants are required to choose the most appropriate answer.
- Time duration will be 20 minutes.
- For each correct answer, participants will be awarded with 3 Marks and there will be negative marking of 1 marks for every wrong answer in this round.
- In case of tie-up in the score, Participant who submitted their response earliest will move to the final round.
- The decision of the evaluation team will be final and will not be subject to any change.
